

Survey work on local roads from 17 November 2025

EnergyCo is carrying out survey work on local roads to inform our planning for the New England Renewable Energy Zone (REZ).

What are we doing?

We will carry out survey work on local roads to inform our environmental assessment and design for the New England REZ.

Work will be carried out at various locations between Muswellbrook and Armidale. The work will primarily be carried out in the road reserve and involves traffic count data collection.

If any access to private property is required, we will consult with landowners directly to arrange access.

Investigation work will include:

- Installing traffic counters (tubes)
- Installing temporary traffic cameras to count vehicles at intersections

Work hours and timing

We will be working from **Monday 17 November to Sunday 7 December between 7am and 6pm, Monday to Friday and 8am to 1pm Saturdays. Some works outside these hours may be required.**

Work will be carried out over a 3-week period.

What will this mean for you?

Survey work on local and state roads may require temporary traffic control speed limits

during installation and removal of survey equipment. Please keep to the speed limits and follow the direction of traffic controllers and signs.
