Drone Survey Work

October 2022

EnergyCo is delivering the Central-West Orana Renewable Energy Zone (REZ) to provide a clean, affordable and reliable power supply for energy consumers across NSW. The REZ will initially unlock three gigawatts of new generation capacity within the next decade, enough to power 1.4 million homes.

Drone survey work

From **Monday 17 October 2022**, EnergyCo will carry out survey work with a drone for the Central-West Orana REZ transmission project in a number of locations throughout Mid-Western, Warrumbungle Shire, and Dubbo local government areas.

The work includes:

- Survey of a small number of local roads, bridges and causeways
- Photography of existing renewable energy infrastructure
- Photography of town centres

Survey work will be carried out by one drone pilot with an assistant using a light vehicle.

How will the work affect you?

The survey work will be carried out between 6am and 6pm, Monday to Friday, for four days between Monday 17 October and Friday 28 October 2022 and is expected to take about one hour in each location.

We will only be carrying out survey work on a small number of local roads, bridges, causeways as well as some town centres. Private property will not be surveyed. Where survey is carried out on road reserve or a public park, a small exclusion zone will be in place for pedestrian and traffic safety.

Why is this happening?

This survey work will assist EnergyCo with technical design and planning by providing higher quality imagery of roads, bridges and existing utilities.

Additional photography will be carried out in a small number of town centres in consultation with councils.
